

# **Pine Tree Park & Campground**

## **Reservation Policy and Camping Regulations**

Pine Tree Park offers 9 primitive camping sites, 10 sites with electric, 13 RV sites with electric and water, and 2 picnic shelters that can be reserved. Reservations can be made by contacting City Hall at (218) 835-4803. Office hours are Monday through Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.; however, you are welcome to leave a voice mail message during off hours.

### **General Information**

**Reservations can be made during the regular camping season for next year.** Please have ready your arrival date, name, address and phone number, length of stay, and site desired. Please have an alternative site in mind, as it is common for the site requested to already be reserved. Reservations will be taken until 12:00 p.m. on Wednesday of each week during the camping season.

### **Cost**

In order to reserve a site, a reservation fee of \$5.00 plus a deposit of the first night's stay is required. The rate for primitive sites is \$20.00 per night without electric, \$25.00 per night with electric, and \$28.00 per night for RV sites with electric and water.

**Each site is limited to 6 persons—if you have more than 6 in your party, another site is needed.**

Two picnic shelters are available for your use. One is located in the RV section, and one is located in the primitive section of the park. To be assured of availability, reservations may be made in advance for \$35.00.

### **Monthly Rates**

Reservations can be made for 30-day periods at the cost of \$525 for a primitive sites with electric, and \$588 for RV Sites with electric and water. This payment must be made in advance.

### **Seasonal Rates**

Reservations can be made on a seasonal basis (Memorial weekend through Labor Day weekend) at a rate of \$1,230 for a primitive sites, and \$1,500 for RV sites. This payment must be paid in advance.

### **Extending Your Visit**

If you wish to extend your camping stay, you must check in with Blackduck City Hall by 11 a.m. to see if your site is available for additional nights. City Hall is open Monday through Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. For changes during the weekend, contact the Campground Host.

### **Cancellations**

The \$5.00 reservation fee is non-refundable. If you cancel more than seven days in advance, your first night's camping fee will be refunded. If canceling a reservation for a picnic shelter, the reservation fee will be refunded less a \$5.00 processing fee. There will be no refund if you cancel less than 7 days in advance.

**Arrival Time** Since the first night's camping fee has been paid in advance, your reservation will be held until check-out time of the following day. If your reservation is for more than one night and you have not occupied your site by the above time described, your reservation will be cancelled and the site will become available to another camper.

### **Check-out Time**

Please clear your site by 2 p.m.

### **Confirming Reservations**

Before you hang up, please verify your arrival date, site, and length of stay. If any corrections need to be made, please contact City Hall as soon as possible.

### **Payment**

A check or money order should be made payable to the City of Blackduck or payment by Credit Card is also available. Payments should be sent to Blackduck City Hall, Pine Tree Park, PO Box 380, Blackduck, MN 56630.

### **Accessibility**

Pine Tree Park offers one accessible site (site 19) for persons with disabilities. A person can only be guaranteed an accessible campsite if a reservation has been made for that site. We hold this campsite so that is it the last to be filled. This helps us meet unseen needs for an accessible site.

In accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), we continue to work toward ensuring Park accessibility to people of all abilities.
